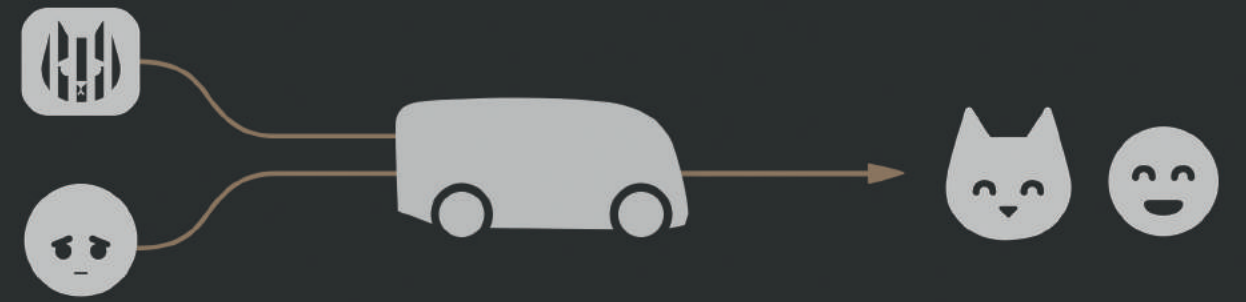


KERUBIM

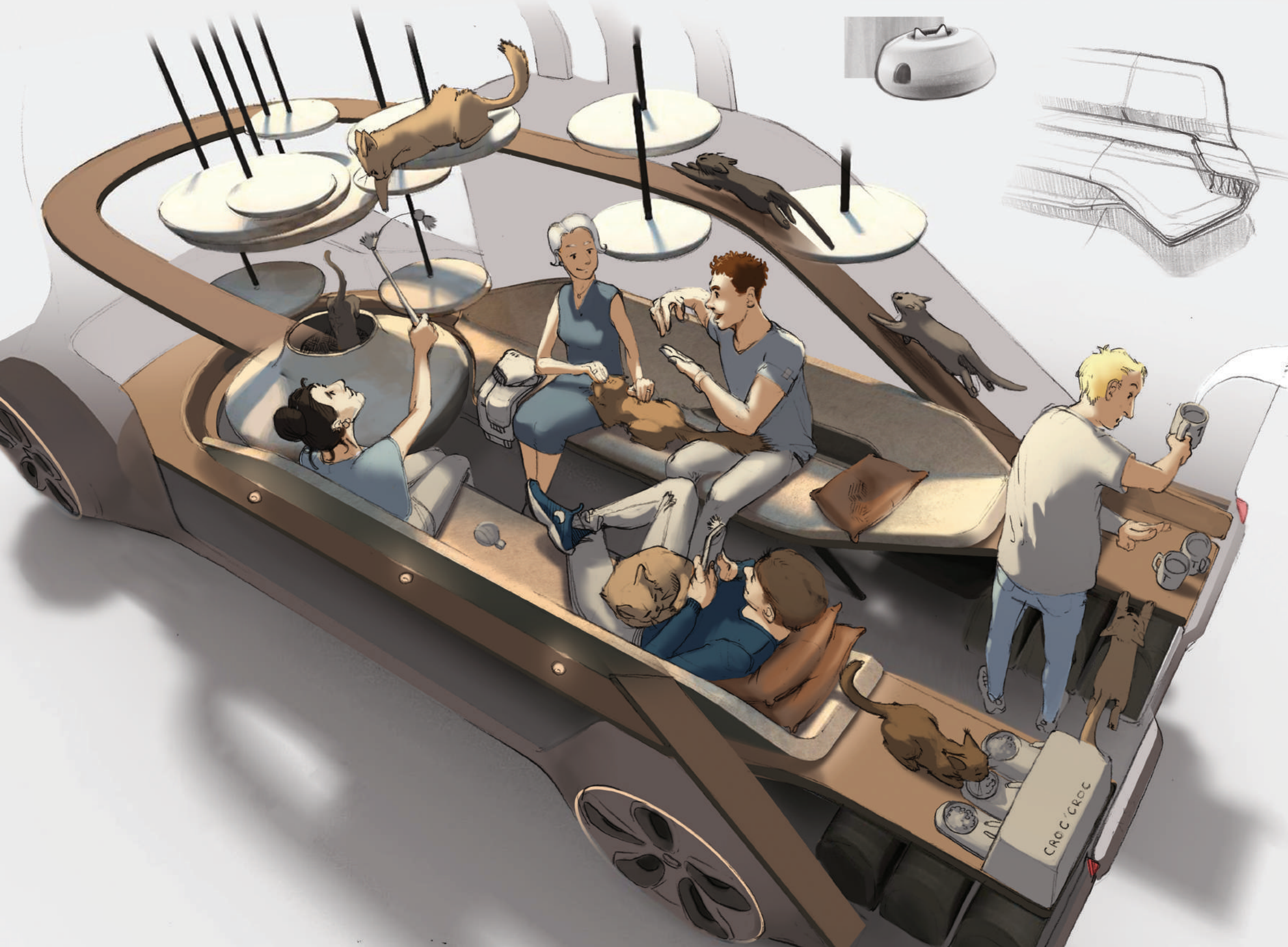
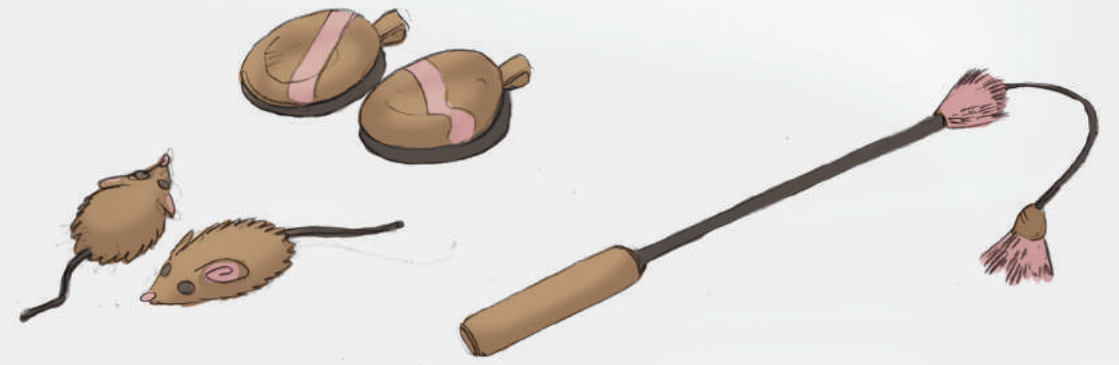
JUST RELAX

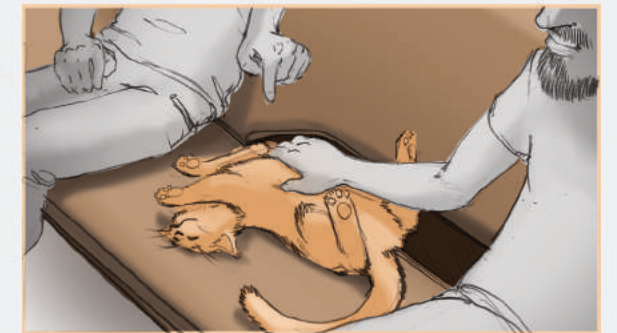
SOCIAL ARCHITECTURE

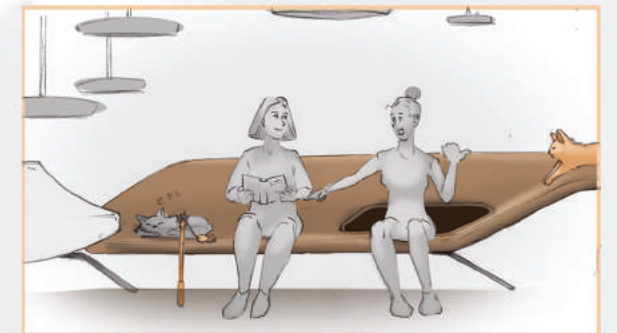
